General Summary	The land survey supervisor oversees a field survey party engaged in establishing highway control points, securing information for the design of highway projects, and determining the locations of right of way and easements. Responsibilities are performed under general supervision.

Examples of Work

- (1) Supervises the gathering and analysis of data necessary to conduct engineering and boundary surveys.
- (2) Supervises deed, title, and map research, monument investigation and control establishment.
- (3) Downloads, processes, and analyzes field work and collected records; prepares reports and archives data files and project field books.
- (4) Supervises and performs mathematical computations and adjustments to set right-of-way and refine control for data collection.
- (5) Confers with supervisor or design personnel to gather data for preliminary and final plans, digital map models, computer data or other information prior to conducting field work.
- (6) Confers with right of way personnel on legal descriptions relating to the acquisition or disposition of right of way to ensure compliance with statute requirements.

- (7) Supervises the production of and signs and seals location survey plats.
- (8) Contacts property owners for permission to enter property; contacts local governments and utility companies to secure information on property plats and section corners.
- (9) Performs supervisory responsibilities in a manner consistent with the department's Affirmative Action Program.
- (10) Performs other responsibilities as required or assigned.
